Administrators, teachers and Instructional Assistants will be provided with trainings and supplemental resources that enhance instructional strategies for English Learners, including At Risk and Long Term English Learners. These supplemental instructional strategies intensify language and literacy teaching. Our technology accelerator, Imagine Learning provides support to Newcomer students. Immigrant support is available for students and their families as needed.

Supplemental professional development and materials will be provided to enhance understanding of the ELA/ELD Framework for teachers, resource teachers, special education teachers, administrators and parents.
