CRITERIA FOR THE EVALUATION OF CONSOLIDATED PROGRAMS

The Governing Board recognizes the importance of implementing academic programs at each school that are of high effectiveness. The Board further recognizes the need for a system that checks the effectiveness of instruction and scheduling on students.

The Board believes that schools that are implementing consolidated programs should demonstrate effectiveness with all special need student populations and that a management system should be in place to support and monitor school and district program development and implementation.
