# LEAD Academy Innovation Camp

The LEAD Academy Innovation Camp is free for incoming 5th and 6th grade students for the 2024-25 school year. Funded through the Expanded Learning Opportunities Program, it is designed to offer students opportunities to explore their strengths and interests and align them with potential careers in the future world of work. Students will participate in hands-on career exploration activities, including design challenges to solve real-world problems. Breakfast, lunch, and snacks are provided.

The highest priority is given to students identified as “unduplicated” (foster youth, unsheltered, students living in motels/hotels, temporarily doubled up, students in temporary shelters, English language learners, and socioeconomically disadvantaged students). After the highest priority students are registered, additional students will be registered on a first-come, first-serve basis.



### Where is the LEAD Academy Innovation Camp Program located?

The LEAD Academy Innovation Camp’s home base will be the Sound Station at 1301 Oleander Avenue in Chula Vista. Students, based on their grades, will take field trips to the Energy, Hydro, and Innovation Stations across Chula Vista.

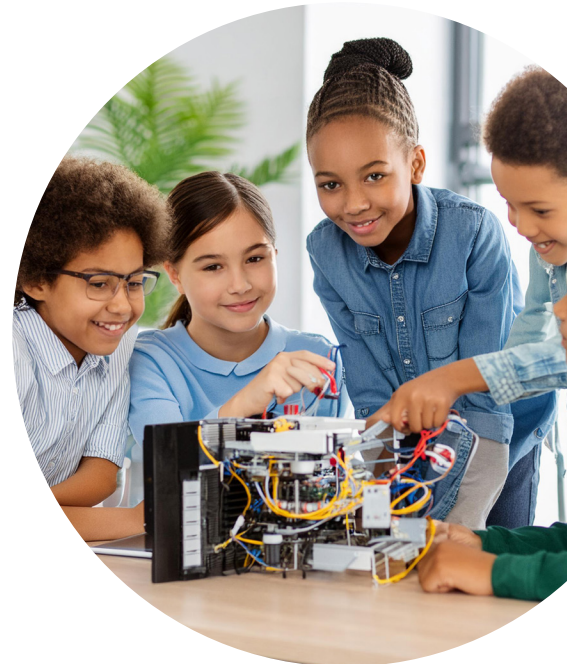
