The LCAP is a three-year plan that outlines how the district plans to meet our students' needs, such as low-income students, English language learners, and foster youth.

State Priorities and Metrics

School districts must report, at minimum, the eight priorities and 26 metrics specified by the State of California, which include conditions of learning, engagement, and pupil outcome.
